Prayer

PRAY IN YOUR INNER ROOM. Matt. 6:6 *But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, close your door and pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you*

PRAY WITH GRATEFUL PRAISE. Matthew 6:9 *Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.*

PRAY WITH HUMBLE DEFERENCE. Matt.6:10 *'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.*

PRAY WITH DAILY DEPENDENCE. Matthew 6:11 *'Give us this day our daily bread.'*

PRAY WITH REFLEXIVE FORGIVENESS. Matthew 6:12 *'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.'*

PRAY WITH PROTECTIVE DELIVERANCE. Matthew 6:13 *'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]'*

PRAY FOR YOUR ENEMIES. Matt. 5:44 *But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.*

PRAY IN THE HOUSE OF GOD. Matthew 21:13 *And He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer'; but you are making it a robbers' den."*

PRAY IN THE EARLY MORNING. Mark 1:35 *In the early morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went away to a secluded place, and was praying there.*

PRAY OFTEN OUT IN NATURE. Luke 5:16 *But Jesus Himself would often slip away to the wilderness and pray.*

PRAY WITH STRENGTHENING ALERTNESS. Luke 21:36 *But keep on the alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are about to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."*

PRAY FOR RECOVERING FAITHFULNESS. Luke 22:32 *but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers."*

PRAY WITH DEVOTED BRETHREN. Acts 2:42 *They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.*

PRAY TO EMPOWER OTHERS. Acts 6:6 *And these they brought before the apostles; and after praying, they laid their hands on them.*

PRAY WITH EMPOWERING FASTING. Acts 13:3 *Then, when they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away.*

PRAY THROUGH YOUR DEEPEST GROANINGS. Romans 8:26 *In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.*

PRAY FOR ENLIGHTENED HEARTS. Ephesians 1:18 *I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,*

PRAY AT ALL TIMES IN THE SPIRIT. Ephesians 6:18 *With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,*

PRAY WITH ABOUNDING LOVE. Philippians 1:9 *And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment.*

PRAY WITH THANKSGIVING. Philippians 4:6 *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.*
