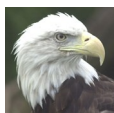


 7 Heart-wired

- 4 Repent...Forgive... and move on.



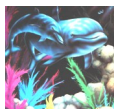
1. Prophecy- Eagle

Born Leader; Visionary
Declares the black & white heart truths of God.



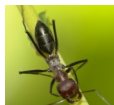
2. Teaching- Tiger

Lifelong learner; Multi-layered
Explains the comprehensive Biblical insights of God.



3. Exhortation- Dolphin

Life of Party; Encourager
Motivates the Body of Christ to apply God's truths.



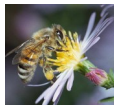
4. Administration- Ant

Looks ahead; Detailed
Organizes & mobilizes the Body of Christ for ministry.



5. Service- Squirrel

Joyful worker; Projects; Private
Performing tasks backstage for others, and for God's glory.



6. Giving- Honey Bee

Generous; Alert; Humble
Distributing the tangible gifts of God to others in His name.



7. Mercy- Dove

Sensitive; Compassionate
Comforting & reassuring others of their high value to God.

Base Passage. Romans 12:6-8 *Since we have gifts that differ . . . according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith; 7 if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; 8 or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads (admin.), with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.*

Prophecy/Eagle. Acts 14:2-6 *Therefore they spent a long time there speaking boldly with reliance upon the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting that signs and wonders be done by their hands. But the multitude of the city was divided...*

Teacher/Tiger. Hebrews 5:12, 14 *For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food... solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.*

Exhortation/Dolphin. Hebrews 10:24-25 *And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.*

Administration/Ant. Proverbs 6:6-8 *Go to the ant, O sluggard, Observe her ways and be wise, Which, having no chief, officer or ruler, Prepares her food in the summer, And gathers her provision in the harvest.*

Service/Squirrel. Mark 10:45 *For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.*
Matthew 25:14-30 Parable of the "talents" (1; 2; 5) 84% Workers; 14% Managers; 2% Visionaries

Giving/Honey Bee. Luke 6:38 *Give, and it will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, they will pour into your lap. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.*

Mercy/Dove. 1 Timothy 1:12-13 *I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me... even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet I was shown mercy because I acted ignorantly in unbelief...*
